### Highlights for 2017

**Jersey Museum** – Discover the story of Jersey from Neolithic Times to the present day, including our most recent exhibition – Bergerac's Island – Jersey in the 1980s. Step inside the beautifully restored Merchant's House and enter the drama of a Victorian family in crisis.

**La Hougue Bie** – La Hougue Bie delivers a truly memorable experience with a medieval chapel which sits above one of Europe's finest passage graves. You can learn about life throughout Jersey's history, from Neolithic times to the German Occupation. You will also see gold jewellery and silver coins from the world's largest Celtic coin hoard.

**Hamptonne Country Life Museum** - Discover six centuries of Jersey's rural life at Hamptonne Country Life Museum. Dating back to the 15th century, the house and farm are brought to life with characters from the Island's past.

**Mont Orgueil Castle** - History comes to life at Mont Orgueil Castle, which for 600 years protected Jersey against French invasion. Explore the network of staircases, towers and rooms to discover hidden treasures.

**Elizabeth Castle** - Built on a rocky islet in St Aubin's Bay, Elizabeth Castle defended Jersey for more than 400 years. This iconic castle is surrounded by the rising tide twice a day, making it a spectacular site to visit whilst in Jersey. Catch one of our famous ferries across to the Castle or walk on foot when the tide is low.

**Maritime Museum** - Absorb yourself in interactive exhibits to feel the force of a gale, understand the tides and watch boat builders work in our purpose built workshop. Immerse yourself in songs and stories of the sea and visit the award winning Occupation Tapestry made by the people of Jersey to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Island's liberation.
