Jersey Museum – Discover the story of Jersey from Neolithic Times to the present day, including our most recent exhibition – Handmade Jersey, which delves into the world of Folk Art. Step inside the beautifully restored Victorian House and enter the drama of a family in crisis.

La Hougue Bie – Explore pre-history from the Neolithic age through to the present day. La Hougue Bie delivers a truly memorable experience with a medieval chapel that sits above one of Europe's finest passage graves and is home to the world's largest Celtic coin hoard.

Hamptonne Country Life Museum - Discover six centuries of Jersey's rural life at Hamptonne Country Life Museum. Dating back to the 15th century, the house and farm are brought to life with characters from the Island's past. Visit the 'Syvret House - Rural Life in the 1940s'- this new exhibition will offer an insight into farm life after the German Occupation.

Mont Orgueil Castle – Located over the beautiful harbour of Gorey for more than 800 years. Mont Orgueil is one of the finest examples of medieval fortresses in existence. Explore the network of staircases, towers and rooms to discover hidden treasures and stories.

Elizabeth Castle - Built on a rocky islet in St Aubin's Bay, Elizabeth Castle defended Jersey for more than 400 years. This iconic castle is surrounded by the rising tide twice a day, making it a spectacular site to visit whilst in Jersey. Catch one of our famous ferries across to the Castle or walk on foot when the tide is low.

Maritime Museum - Absorb yourself in interactive exhibits to feel the force of a gale, understand the tides and watch boat builders work in our purpose built workshop. Immerse yourself in songs and stories of the sea and visit the award winning Occupation Tapestry made by the people of Jersey to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Island's liberation.
