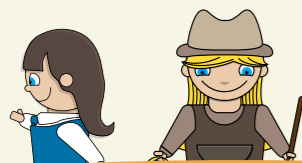


WANT TO MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR SUMMER HOLIDAYS?

-  1. Make your own catapult at Mont Orgueil's Castle Quest week (20-24 July, 10am-4pm).
-  2. Become a trainee archaeologist at La Hougue Bie's Archaeological Adventures week (27-31 July, 10am-4pm).
-  3. Make a mini marauder ship and Jolly Roger flag at the Maritime Museum's Maritime Marauders week (3-7 August, 10am-4pm).
-  4. Learn about animal habitats at Hopping Hamptonne week (10-14 August, 10am-4pm).
-  5. Make a crown and sceptre at Elizabeth Castle's Kings & Queens week (17-21 August, 10am-4pm).
-  6. Become a private detective; find the hidden clues at Jersey Museum during Museum Mysteries week (24-28 August, 10am-4pm).




ACTIVE ADVENTURES...

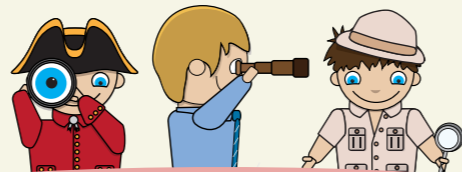
-  7. Join the weekly activity camps at Elizabeth Castle, featuring abseiling, archery, kayaking and orienteering with Jersey Adventures. Call (01534) 873074 to book.
-  8. Get your walking boots on, with downloadable walks from www.jerseyheritage.org, including:
 - First Tower to Elizabeth Castle Ferry
 - Upstream to Hamptonne
 - Howard Davis Park to Maritime Museum
-  9. Take a stroll down the Five Mile Road and spot Barge Aground, Kempst Tower, Lewis's Tower & La Rocco Tower along the way. www.jerseyheritage.org/holiday

-  10. Walk to Seymour Tower and explore the sea life hidden in the rock pools. Make sure you check the tides and take a grown up.
-  11. Hike the 2.8 mile path around Val de La Mare Reservoir, and spot the owls' nesting boxes.
-  12. Climb to the top of Green Island when the tide is out.






WATCH HISTORY COME ALIVE & HUNT FOR TREASURE...

-  13. Find the hidden secrets of Elizabeth Castle with Huntzz, the free digital treasure hunt (see back cover for details).
-  14. Watch the Midday Parade and hear the Noonday gun being fired at Elizabeth Castle (every day except Sundays).
-  15. Find out what's missing from the large gold box at Jersey Museum, with Huntzz, the free digital treasure hunt.
-  16. Learn about 17th century cooking with the Goodwyf at Hamptonne (every day, 10am-4pm).
-  17. Discover what's concealed in the cod's mouth at the Maritime Museum, with Huntzz, the free digital treasure hunt.
-  18. Listen to the dramatic tales of the Prince's Tower at the time of The Battle of Waterloo with Cally (La Hougue Bie, Mondays, 10am-4pm).



SEARCH FOR SIGHTS...

-  19. Find a selfie spot in the Claude Cahun exhibition and take a picture of yourself (Jersey Museum).
-  20. Watch the conservators uncover new finds in the Celtic hoard, in the Treasure: Uncovering the Hoard exhibition (Jersey Museum).
-  21. Track down the Devil statue at Devil's Hole.

-  22. See how Jersey looked in days gone by in the 'Your story, our history - 125 years seen through a Jersey Evening Post lens' exhibition (Jersey Museum).
-  23. Watch a fabulous sunset from St Ouen's beach.
-  24. Find the hand-stitched sampler made by Elizabeth Anna Marret in 1736 in the Stitched Memories sampler exhibition (Hamptonne).
-  25. Take your own archaeological finds (and we don't mean your dad!) to the archaeologists at Les Varines. They might be able to tell you what they are. Parking at JCG (26 July, 10am-3pm).
-  26. Climb to the top of Mont Orgueil Castle and see if you can spot France on the horizon.








EXCITING EXPERIENCES TO REMEMBER...

-  28. Ride your bike up the Railway Walk from St Aubin to Corbière.
-  29. Travel back in time and discover your family history at the Jersey Archive.
-  30. Build a sandcastle in front of Elizabeth Castle. Be careful the sea doesn't wash it away!
-  31. Delve into our dressing up box and have an adventure at Mont Orgueil Castle.
-  32. Visit La Hougue Bie and make a little person to be added to the Les P'tits Faïchieux collection.

-  41. Search for wall lizards at Mont Orgueil Castle.
