



Jersey Heritage Dog Policy:

As an organisation that protects and maintains historic buildings and landscapes, unfortunately we cannot allow dogs onto our sites because:

- JH sites are often great places for our Island's biodiversity to flourish. Scents left by dogs can scare wildlife and attract predatory animals.
- Some JH sites have free-roaming animals living in them which might be distressed by dogs.
- Some activities like cannon firing and musketry demonstration can be noisy and might scare dogs.
- Dogs at heritage sites can adversely affect the experience of our sites for some visitors.
- Dog mess can be a problem.
- Guide dogs are of course an exception.
